PH.D. ADMISSION PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED W.E.F. FALL 2024 ACROSS ALL SCHOOLS IN MU

Ph.D. admissions w.e.f. the Fall Semester 2024 will be made as per UGC guidelines and in conjunction with Clause (9) Admission Eligibility Criteria, including admission process of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) Regulations, as approved by the Board of Management & Governing Body of Mahindra University vide meeting held on 20th July 2020 through the following processes/procedure:

- All admissions will be made on the basis of UGC-NET Score / the Written Test to 1. be conducted independently by the Mahindra University, which will have a weightage of 60 marks and an interview with a weightage of 40 marks. Merit list for admission to MU's PhD program will be drawn by drawing the total marks obtained by a candidate at these two components out of a total of 100 (60 + 40) marks.
- For the candidates having cleared and having valid UGC-NET examination score, 2. for admission purpose their UGC-NET performance would be given a weightage of **30/60**, by default.
- If, however, any UGC-NET cleared candidate wishes to improve his/her written 3. test component score beyond 30/60, he/she can take the written test (to be conducted by MU) and best of the two scores will be used for admission purpose besides the marks in the interview to be conducted by MU for all candidates seeking admission to MU's PhD program.

The above process for admission to PhD program at MU effective Fall 2024 will be applicable to all the schools under MU.
