Guidelines for a 2-page Extended Abstract

A two-page extended abstract template requires the title, authors, affiliations, and an abstract text, followed by an introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, and conclusion. The two pages must include all content, such as figures, tables, and references, and should be prepared with specific formatting, including single-spaced text and one-inch margins, as outlined by the template's provider. No page numbers, headers, or footers should be included.

Formatting and structure

- Page layout: Use a standard A4 page with 1-inch (2.5 cm) margins on all sides.
- Text: Single-spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font is a common requirement.
- Page numbers: Do not include page numbers, headers, or footers.
- **Justification:** Text should be justified, with lines aligned to the right and no syllable segmentation.
- **Headings:** Use headings for each section: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, and Conclusion.

Content requirements

- **Title, Author, Affiliation:** The abstract begins with the full paper title, author(s) name(s), affiliation, and e-mail address. Indicate the presenter with an asterisk (*).
- **Abstract:** A brief summary of the study's objective, findings, and conclusions (max 150–250 words).
- **Keywords:** List up to five keywords in alphabetical order.
- **Introduction:** Provide background information, state the study's objective, and briefly explain its relevance and how it differs from previous work.
- Materials and Methods: Describe the equipment, materials, and procedures used in sufficient detail.
- **Results and Discussion:** Present the main findings, which can be combined.

- **Conclusion:** Summarize the research's discoveries and implications, and mention limitations or future research directions.
- **Figures and Tables:** Include a maximum of one figure and one table, if necessary. Ensure they are clearly labeled and fit within the two-page limit.
- **References:** Cite references in the text using bracketed numbers. [1], [2].

Additional guidelines

• **Figures:** Ensure figures are high-resolution (e.g., 300 dpi) and have captions below them.




Fig. 4. Drag Force as a Function of Velocity in different Directions

• Tables: Place the table caption above the table. Reference tables sequentially, like Table 1.
